



Coaches Code of Conduct

- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support to all players, other coaches, officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my players ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will teach that doing one's best, competing fairly and having fun is more important than winning.
- I will avoid the use of alcohol, drugs, and tobacco products when in contact with players.
- I will remember that these activities are for youth – not for adults.
- I will teach the players to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect, regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will not use offensive language or gestures.
- I will exert my influence to enhance sportsmanship by working directly with my players and parents.
- I will respect and support contest officials, I will not indulge in conduct that would incite players or spectators against the officials.
- I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement while coaching for the Boys and Girls Club of Benton County. I acknowledge that inappropriate behavior is cause for immediate action and that if a repeat offense occurs it will result in no longer coaching for the Boys and Girls Club of Benton County.
