- I will get my child to games and practice on time.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support to all players, coaches, officials at every game, practice, or other youth sports event.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will teach my child that doing one's best, competing fairly and having fun is more important than winning.
- I will support the coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and will refrain from its use at all youth sports events.
- I will remember that these activities are for youth – not for adults.
- I will help my child to enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with the coaching or providing transportation.
- I will teach my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect, regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will not use offensive language or gestures.
- I will abide by a physician's decision in all matters of my child's health and injuries and physical ability to play.
- I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in the Boys and Girls Club of Benton County athletic program. I acknowledge that inappropriate behavior is cause for immediate ejection from the stands and that a repeat offenses will result in being banned from future games and league sponsored events.
